**Commercial**



This is where a business **AIMS TO MAKE A PROFIT** from the services it provides.

**Non-commercial**



This is when a service is provided but **DOES NOT AIM TO MAKE A PROFIT** from them.

**Residential**

This is a business that provides accommodation as well as catering.



**Non-residential**

This is a business that provides catering but not accommodation.



**Establishment**

A place where a business or organisation is run from.
