


Kemnal Keys: Geography – Map Skills

What you should know	What you should be able to do
Where the main four direction are on a compass, remembering Never Eat Shredded Wheat – going clockwise from the top.	State which compass direct to travel in if going between two locations e.g. China → Australia is south.
The seven continents of the world are: Africa, North America, South America, Europe, Asia, Oceania, Antarctica	Identify and label the continents of the world.
The five oceans of the world are: Indian, Atlantic, Pacific, Southern, Arctic	Identify and label the oceans of the world.
The five nations of the British Isles are: England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland, Republic of Ireland	Identify and label the nations on a map. State which nations are part of the UK and Great Britain.
Distance on a map is shown using a scale bar .	Measure or estimate the distance between locations using the scale bar on a map.
Land height is shown on a map using contours . The shape of the land is called topography or relief .	Read the land height of a specific point on a map using contours. Calculate the difference in land height between two points on a map using contours.
Accurate locations of specific map features are given using grid references .	Read both four figure and six figure grid references (along the corridor, up the stairs). Locate the feature found at a given grid reference on a map. State the grid reference of a given map feature.
Map features are illustrated with map symbols .	Identify the majority of OS map symbols on a map.



